Despite the pandemic we were still able to host a few social events. This included free ice cream deliveries to raise spirits and pictures with a fun life sized Santa cardboard cutout! The directory and newsletters went out as usual. We delivered welcome bags to many new neighbors and tried to assist them in the transition to the neighborhood. We also helped many homeowners solve issues with the township.

You may remember that usually we ask for membership renewal in August/September and kick off the year with our annual Neighborhood gathering. From now on, that will be a little bit different. We changed the association to follow a calendar year. Your dues now cover your membership from January - December.

How can I help?

We continue to look for new ideas and people to make those ideas come to life. If you have a few extra hours per year we would love your help. What is it?

Formed in 1974, the NWTHA was established in response to two subdivisions (now known as Springbrook Crossings and Brook Crossings Estates) and a commercial area (Leverenz Plaza) that would be annexed to Naperville. We hired an attorney, testified before Naperville's City Council and succeeded in modifying the proposed development (no apartment buildings or townhouses, smaller commercial area, larger lots, etc.). The rest, as they say, is history.

Who is in the association?

The NWTHA is made up of about 450 member families who live in Country View Estates, Sunset Ridge, Wheatland View, Shannon's Way, Acorn Estates, Shell Lake, River Crest subdivisions, and homes along Knoch Knolls Road and Mayfield Court. We also have recently had people who live in incorporated Naperville join to take advantage of some of the fun events we offer.

Why should I join?

The NWTHA board is committed to creating a neighborhood where everyone feels heard and is able to feel part of the community. We offer a variety of events that people of all ages enjoy. Most of these events are free. We also provide an easy way to get your questions about the neighborhood answered. Please reach out. We are here to help.

What can I look forward to?
